

## General Rules for Oklahoma Close Up Student Participants

1. Teachers are required to bring students with them. No student participant will be permitted to use his/her own car while attending Oklahoma Close Up.
2. No room visitation between male or female participants is permitted. Security guards are provided by Oklahoma Close Up.
3. The cost of any vandalism will be charged to those committing the act.
4. Possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco products by participants is strictly forbidden.
5. All participants are expected to be at bus pick ups on time and to attend all scheduled meetings. A nurse will be in attendance to excuse those participants who become ill.
6. All participants will check out of their rooms before the Friday morning bus pick up.
7. All participants are required to cooperate with Oklahoma Close Up personnel at all times. Inappropriate behavior is strictly forbidden.
8. For the security of participants, no visitors are allowed on program.
9. School dress is appropriate for the Program. However, baseball caps or other headgear, bare midriffs and sunglasses (indoors) are not acceptable.
10. Cell phones & other electronic devices must be turned off during speakers and breakout sessions.

The above rules will be strictly enforced. Any infraction will be grounds for immediate dismissal from the Oklahoma Close Up program. The teacher sponsor, parent/guardian, and principal will be notified immediately if a participant is dismissed. **If you are dismissed, you will be returned home at you OWN expense with no refund of program expenses.**

### General Information

- Students should wear comfortable shoes, as there will be a considerable amount of walking during the program.
- School dress is appropriate for the program. It is suggested the student bring one dress outfit for the banquet on Thursday evening.
- Nametags must be worn during all scheduled activities. Also, remember to bring your packet.
